

Classroom Rules

- 1. COME TO CLASS WITH AN OPEN MIND AND AN OPEN HEART.** Be prepared to succeed. **Keep PRIDE in mind.**
- 2. ALL ELECTRONIC DEVICES SHOULD BE CLOSED/OFF DURING LECTURES and CLASS DISCUSSIONS.**
3. *If your are receiving a grade of C- or lower in any class, the teacher has the prerogative to take away your privilege to use music while completing homework assignments. No exceptions.
4. **BATHROOM PASS.** Please use the bathroom during passing periods. You will be given only 8 bathroom passes per semester. Use the bathroom pass appropriately.
5. **WORKSHEETS AND/OR HOMEWORK COMPLETION.**
Weekly calendars and class binders will be checked every Friday and randomly during the week. List all class homework on your calendars. See green sheets for grade calculations.
6. **SHOW RESPECT WHEN A PERSON IS SPEAKING.**
Unnecessary conversations are not allowed during class time. Raise your hand if you have something to contribute to the discussion. Respect other's views.
7. **ATTENDANCE AND TARDIES.** You are expected to come to class on time. When you are not in your seats when the tardy bell rings you will be marked tardy. Five **CONSECUTIVE TARDIES** and 3 **UNEXCUSED ABSENCES**, student will be assigned Friday night school. If absences and tardies continue, student will be placed in an attendance contract. Excused absences require excuse slips, parent phone call or doctor's note.

8. CLASSROOM BEHAVIOR.

- a. Respect for adults and peers are expected of all students.
- b. Appropriate conversations and appropriate language is encouraged.
- c. Proper classroom conduct is expected.
- d. Sharpen pencils only during class breaks.
- e. Raise your hand if you would like to say something.
- f. Respect all classroom rules.

DISCIPLINE: Any violation of the above rules will result in one or more of the following:

1. **First offense:** VERBAL WARNING.
2. **Second offense:** RELOCATION within the classroom.
3. **Third offense:** FIVE-MINUTE BREAK, if necessary or student will be allowed to work in a quiet area (e.g. Library) with the supervision of the IA. (Teacher will review BSP if appropriate).
4. **Fourth offense:** BEHAVIORAL REFERRAL. Student will be taken to the Assistant Principal for discipline, phone call to parent,
5. **Fifth offense:** BEHAVIOR PLAN and IEP meeting. **Behavior contract.**
